¹ Of the 784,494 cases, 244,736 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 241,985 cases were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Use of a Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these 241,985 cases, 512 were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing information on offender's race (498) or missing information on drug type (15).
