IFCD is an Indiana not-for-profit corporation and represents indigent persons charged with crimes in the Indianapolis and Terre Haute Divisions of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana, and in the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit and the United States Supreme Court. Our office is located in Indianapolis and follows a hybrid work model, allowing attorneys to incorporate telework when consistent with obligations to clients and the court.

Candidates must be admitted to the practice of law and eligible for admission to the bar of the Southern District of Indiana. The ideal candidate will be passionate, a good team player, demonstrate compassion for those persons we represent, and will have a resume that shows a demonstrated commitment to indigent defense in criminal cases. Applicants should expect to defend cases involving guns, drugs, violent crimes, sex offenses, complex conspiracies, and fraud.
