4. Membership on the panels will be reviewed by the District Court Judges, the Chief Federal Defender, and the CJA Panel Selection Committee annually. Appointed panel members will serve three-year terms and retention on the panel requires 1) submission to the IFCD listserv and email, and 2) 6 hours of attendance at CLE programs directed at criminal defense each year. Attorneys on the panel will be required to certify satisfaction of these minimum requirements to retain their panel position at the end of each three-year term.

Additionally, Developmental Panel attorneys will be required to attend additional trainings provided by the Federal Defenders and covering the basics of federal criminal defense.
